5. Maintaining appropriate internal emergency response capabilities and coordinating with external emergency responders to effectively respond to situations that involve our products or that may impact our employees and other stakeholders.
6. Undertaking periodic reviews of our assets, operations and activities to measure the organization's performance and compliance with this policy, applicable laws, and other requirements.
7. Setting objectives and targets intended to improve the organization's performance and to drive continuous improvement.
8. Applying appropriate process safety and risk management principles to all manufacturing processes.
9. Adhering to basic security measures to protect our employees and other stakeholders including protection of products and other assets; and
10. Maintaining procedures that promote the safe storage and transportation of our raw materials and products.
